**DOCKET U-4294 – BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC. AND MADISON RIVER COMMUNICATIONS, LLC** – Interconnection Agreement negotiated by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (“BellSouth”) and Madison River Communications, LLC pursuant to §252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996. **Approved**

**SUMMARY OF OTHER FILINGS**

**D-5775 – FRONTIER COMMUNICATIONS OF AMERICA, INC.** – Introduces Frontier Small Business Advantage LD. Version B, Small Business Advantage LD, Version B, is a long distance product that includes direct dial 1+ intrastate and interstate outbound service, and option (8XX) toll free inbound service. This product is only available to business customers who subscribe to Frontier Small Business Advantage LD plan. Filed July 7, 2006, with a requested effective date of July 10, 2006. **Approved**

**D-5779 – ROPIR INDUSTRIES D/B/A ROPIR COMMUNICATIONS** – Reduces rates for Intrastate Long Distance Basic Service Charges. Filed July 17, 2006, with a requested effective date of August 16, 2006. **Approved**

**D-5786 – GTC, INC. D/B/A GT COM** – Introduces new options to Custom Calling Services, Bundled Local Service, Advance Calling Services, and Advance Calling Service – Package Features offerings. Filed July 25, 2006, with a requested effective date of August 25, 2006. **Approved**

**D-5787 – CENTURYTEL LONG DISTANCE, LLC D/B/A CENTURYTEL LONG DISTANCE, INC.** – Introduces the Simple Choice Unlimited II Long Distance Plan. This service provides unlimited intrastate and interstate direct-dial outbound for Residential customers. Rates vary from \$44.95 to \$49.95 depending on which exchange area the customer resides. Filed July 21, 2006, with a requested effective date of July 25, 2006. **Approved**

**D-5790 – UNION SPRINGS TELEPHON COMPANY** – Changes the standard Area Calling Service usage charge to 8 cents per minute for any time of day. The current rate schedule is organized by mileage bands with per-minute rates ranging from 7 to 16 cents per minute. The Company anticipates a net revenue decrease from the changes. Filed July 27, 2006, with a requested effective date of September 1, 2006. **Approved**

**D-5797 – NATIONAL TELEPHONE OF ALABAMA, INC.** – Eliminates restriction on the Resale of Telecommunications Services, and provides for the resale of such services at a wholesale discount pursuant to contracts between the Company and certified carriers. Filed July 31, 2006, with a requested effective date of August 31, 2006. **Approved**

**D-5798 – PEOPLES TELEPHONE COMPANY D/B/A TDS TELECOM** – Introduces N11 Abbreviated Dialing Codes service. Currently, the Tariff only provides for 711 service. The existing 711 Tariff pages are replaced by pages incorporating all N11 service offerings including 711. Filed August 1, 2006, with a requested effective date of August 16, 2006. **Approved**

**D-5799 – OAKMAN TELEPHONE COMPANY** - Introduces N11 Abbreviated Dialing Codes service. Currently, the Tariff only provides for 711 service. The existing 711 Tariff pages are replaced by pages incorporating all N11 service offerings including 711. Filed August 1, 2006, with a requested effective date of August 16, 2006. **Approved**

**D-5800 – BUTLER TELEPHONE COMPANY** - Introduces N11 Abbreviated Dialing Codes service. Currently, the Tariff only provides for 711 service. The existing 711 Tariff pages are replaced by pages incorporating all N11 service offerings including 711. Filed August 1, 2006, with a requested effective date of August 16, 2006. **Approved**

### **LEGAL DIVISION**

**DOCKET 29878(G)** – Implementation of the Code of Alabama, 1975 §37-2A-4(j) requiring certain telecommunications carriers to submit plans for the protection/confidentiality of the physical address/location of family violence shelters. The Alabama Coalition Against Domestic Violence (“ACADV”) has reviewed the plans previously submitted by telecommunications carriers of Alabama to protect the confidentiality of the physical address/location of family violence shelters and has submitted a proposed template for all companies to follow.

**Recommend: Publication of the ACADV template (with some minor modifications by staff) for comment by interested parties.**
