LEGAL DIVISION

DOCKET 29878 (G) – Implementation of the provisions of §37-2A-4(j), Code of Alabama 1975, as amended. (Plans for the Protection of Domestic Violence Shelter locations) Comments were solicited and received in this matter. In addition, a workshop was conducted by Commission staff on January 17, 2007. The participating carriers and the Alabama Coalition Against Domestic Violence (“ACADV”) worked out their differences and agreed on certain administrative procedures that will pave the way for approval of all the proposed plans currently filed with the Commission. Staff from Telecommunications and Advisory recommend approval of all plans currently filed and the entry of an order setting forth the agreed upon administrative procedures.

RECOMMEND: Entry of an order establishing the administrative procedures agreed to by the parties approving the plans that have already been submitted.
