**DOCKET 29733 (Proposed) (G)** – In re: Generic Proceeding to Consider the Implications of the Communications Reform Act of 2005. The Communications Reform Act of 2005 has a number of deadlines that will require transition from a substantially regulated telecommunications environment to one that is largely deregulated. The purpose of the generic proceeding will be to establish a dialogue with industry participants aimed at resolving potential transitional issues. **RECOMMEND: Issuance of an Order establishing the generic proceedings in seeking initial comments on the issues to be addressed therein**
