## LEGAL DIVISION

**DOCKET 28292(G)** – In re: Complaint by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. against Global Crossing Telecommunications, Inc. regarding practices in reporting of percent interstate usage for compensation for jurisdictional access services. Settlement agreement has been reached.

**RECOMMEND: Dismissal of complaint**

**DOCKET 28882 AND 28883(G)** – BellSouth E911 tariff filings. Docket 28882 entails BellSouth's proposed imposition of a \$190 monthly recurring rate for the use of its existing Automatic Location Information ("ALI") database. Docket 28883 involves a filing by BellSouth to introduce a new database service, Emergency Service Provider Data Service ("ESPDS") which is mandated by 47 U.S.C. §222(g) – (h). The E911 Boards of the counties of Cullman, Shelby, Etowah, Walker and Cleburne intervened in both filings. BellSouth filed a Motion to Dismiss those Petitions due primarily to the Petitioners' alleged lack of standing to intervene. The E911 Boards each filed Responses to BellSouth's Motion to Dismiss claiming the requisite standing to intervene.

**RECOMMEND: Even though the E911 Boards in question do have the requisite standing to intervene, their Petition to Intervene and their Responses to BellSouth's Motion to Dismiss are at best vague. The E911 Boards do not specifically challenge the reasonableness of the involved rates. Therefore, the recommendation is to issue an order requiring the E911 Boards to show cause as to why the tariffs in question are unreasonable and/or demonstrating why a hearing concerning said tariffs should be held. BellSouth will have an opportunity to respond to any such pleadings submitted by the E911 Boards prior to a determination being rendered by the Committee.**
