## **LEGAL DIVISION**

**DOCKET 26797;25406(G)** – Petition of Otelco Telecommunications, LLC (“Otelco”) to expand its existing Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity authorizing the provision of local exchange and telephone toll resale service to also include authority to provides resold and facilities-based competitive local exchange service throughout the state of Alabama.

**Recommend:** Grant subject to Otelco’s submission of an affirmative waiver of the company’s right to assert the provisions of 47 USC §251(f)(1)(A) – (C) which generally exempt rural telephone companies like Otelco from complying with the requirements of 47 USC §251 (C) absent a state commission finding that it is not economically burdensome, technically feasible and inconsistent with 47 USC §251 for such companies to do so.

**DOCKET (G)** – The Telecommunications Division recommends the establishment of a generic proceeding to determine whether providers of prison pay telephone service are eligible to elect to operate under the Communications Reform Act of 2005.

**Recommend:** Issuance of an order establishing the generic proceeding recommended and seeking comments from interested parties.
