(“BellSouth”) and CenturyTel Solutions, LLC pursuant to §251 and §252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996. Recommend Approval

Docket U-4509 – BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC. (“BELLSOUTH”) AND HAYNEVILLE FIBER TRANSPORT – Amended Interconnection Agreement negotiated by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (“BellSouth”) and Hayneville Fiber Transport pursuant to §251 and §252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996. Recommend Approval
