DOCKET U-4393 – ALLTEL ALABAMA, INC. AND CAT COMMUNICATIONS INTERNATIONAL, INC. – Interconnection Agreement negotiated by Alltel Alabama, Inc. and CAT Communications International, Inc. pursuant to §252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996. **Approved**

DOCKET U-4700 – CENTURYTEL AND CELLCO PARTNERSHIP, VERIZON WIRELESS OF THE EAST LP, GTE MOBILNET OF FLORENCE, ALABAMA INCORPORATED, GADSDEN CELLTELCO PARTNERSHIP AND TUSCALOOSA CELLULAR PARTNERSHIP ALL D/B/A VERIZON WIRELESS – Interconnection Agreement negotiated by CenturyTel and Cellco Partnership, Verizon Wireless of the East LP, GTE Mobilnet of Florence, Alabama Incorporated, Gadsden CellTelCo Partnership and Tuscaloosa Cellular all d/b/a Verizon Wireless pursuant to §252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996. **Approved**

DOCKET 28590 – GULF TELEPHONE COMPANY, GRACEBA TOTAL COMMUNICATIONS AND ALLTEL ALABAMA, INC. – Petition for approval to move from the Price Cap Plan to the Price Flexibility Plan pursuant to the Alabama Telecommunications Regulation Plan approved December 27, 2004. **Approved**

D-5417 – CENTURYTEL LONG DISTANCE, LLC – Increases per-minute rates for Matchmaker, a basic switched toll service. Filed September 6, 2005, with an effective date of September 9, 2005. **Approved**

D-5420 – CENTURYTEL OF ALABAMA, LLC – Withdraws the Wireless Termination Tariff. Filed September 1, 2005, with an effective date of September 1, 2005. **Approved**

D-5431 – HAYNEVILLE TELEPHONE COMPANY, INC. – Introduces Enhanced Area Calling Service – ACS 1200 Plan. Deletes rates for Residential Local Calling Plans. Filed September 1, 2005, with a requested effective date of October 30, 2005. **Approved**

D-5437 – FRONTIER COMMUNICATIONS OF ALABAMA, LLC – Introduces Electronic Bill Payment Program. Filed September 14, 2005, with a requested effective date of October 16, 2005. **Approved**

D-5438 – FRONTIER COMMUNICATIONS OF LAMAR COUNTY, LLC - Introduces Electronic Bill Payment Program. Filed September 19, 2005, with a requested effective date of October 17, 2005. **Approved**

D-5439 – FRONTIER COMMUNICATIONS OF THE SOUTH, LLC - Introduces Electronic Bill Payment Program. Filed September 16, 2005, with a requested effective date of October 16, 2005. **Approved.**

LEGAL DIVISION

DOCKET 26397(G) – Petition of Mon-Cre Wireless, Inc. d/b/a Mon-Cre Long Distance, Inc. for an extension of time within which to file a final tariff governing the company's long distance service offerings.

Recommend: Grant of one year extension

DOCKET 28988(G) – Declaratory Ruling upholding the applicability of Rural ILEC tariff provisions governing compensation for indirect CMRS traffic. The Rural ILECs submitted a motion to this cause (on or about August 22, 2005) wherein the Rural ILECs sought application of their tariffs to all indirect mobile to land intraMTA traffic terminated by the Rural ILECs from CMRS provider T-Mobile from the effective date of T-Mobile's meet point billing conversion with BellSouth through April 29, 2005.

Recommend: Approval of Petition as consistent with the Commission's January 26, 2004, Order entered in this cause as well as the current orders of the FCC

DOCKET 28850(G) - Citizen Phone, Inc. v. CenturyTel of Alabama, LLC d/b/a CenturyTel. On or about September 6, 2005, CenturyTel submitted a Motion for Final Order Setting Amount Owed on Account. Citizen Phone, Inc. has not responded to said Motion.

Recommend: Issuance of Default Judgement establishing the total amount which Citizen owes CenturyTel at \$228,195.82 unless Citizen shows good cause disputing the amount within 10 days.

DOCKET 29393(G) – TRRO Declaratory Ruling Proceedings. Momentum Telecom, Inc. ("Momentum") seeks reconsideration of the Commission's vote of August 2, 2005 wherein Momentum's Motion for Clarification of the Commission's May 25, 2005 Order in this cause was partially granted and partially denied. Specifically, the Commission voted on August 2, 2005, to require BellSouth to provision UNE "adds and changes" to service the embedded customer base of CLECs like Momentum, but voted to deny Momentum's request that BST be required to service the embedded customer base of CLECs

with respect to “moves”. Momentum now urges the Commission to expand its August 2, 2005 ruling by requiring BellSouth to also provision UNE “moves” for the embedded customer base of CLECs like Momentum.

Recommend: Denial of Motion for Reconsideration based on reasoning set forth in previous recommendation and in the proposed order which has been circulated for signature
